I have won twice the "German-junior handling-Final" (2002 and 2003) and represented my country at the International junior handling Competition at Crufts (2003 and 2004). Furthermore I won the junior handling Final in Monaco in 2004 which gave me the opportunity to represented Monaco at Crufts 2005. I became Runner Up junior handler at Crufts 2005. The first German junior handler to achieve a placement at Crufts.

I have judged the junior handling Competitions in Germany, Sweden, Australia, in Split-Croatia at the famous Summer Night Dogshow, Helsinki Winner Show, World Dog Show in Milano, Italy and at the World Dog Show in Germany.

I have shown dogs all over Europe, America and Australia. We have bred, owned and shown dogs to many World Winner, European Winner, champion titles and Group and BIS awards. One of the biggest successes was winning the Eukanuba Challenge in Germany and having the opportunity to represent Germany 4 times. 2009 with one of our very own bred Tibetan Terriers "Multi CH. Ti La Shu United Magic Colours". He represented the Country in Long Beach, USA. And we had the great honour to represent our country again at Crufts at the Eukanuba World Challenge 2017 with our Tibetan Terrier "Kivi" and 2018 with our "Chilli". 2019 we won the Top Dog of the year in Germany again with our Tibetan Terrier "Peanut".

I have shown dogs at Crufts many years and won two times Best of Breed over 250 entered dogs in 2016 and 2017.

In 2022 our own bred dog "Holly" Ti La Shu P.S. I Love you won the Group at the World Dog Show in Madrid. For sure every handler and breeders dream
