Seek funding for your research

If you are a researcher on companion animals you have the opportunity to apply for funds from Agria and the SKK Research Fund.

The fund finances research related to veterinary medicine, genetics and ethology. We also support projects concerning the psychological, economic and social importance of companion animals for humans and society.

Who can apply?

Reserarchers in Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Norway and Germany can apply for funds from Agria and SKK Research Fund.

The main applicant must be a Ph D or have equivalent scientific experience and be affiliated with a university, research institution or other organization such as animal hospitals.

Announcement takes place in two stages

The announcement takes place in two stages where the applicant in the first stage, Stage 1, leaves a brief description of the proposed project with a focus on the project's relevance and benefit for the pet sector.

Those Stage 1 applications that are approved proceed to the next stage, Stage 2.

Applicants must then submit a full-scale application that is assessed with regard to relevance and scientific quality.

Funds can be applied for one, two or three years. The application can be made for a maximum of one million kroner per year including OH costs.
