

Exceptions to the SKK Show regulations

European Dog Show and Swedish Winner Show 2026

At the European Dog Show and the Swedish Winner Show, held on 4–6 September 2026, the Swedish Kennel Club's (SKK) Show regulations will apply, subject to the exceptions set out below.

The same regulations apply to both the European Dog Show and the Swedish Winner Show, with the exception of the final competitions that are organised.

Breeds

Both shows follows the FCI breed classification.

Exceptions to the SKK Show regulations

The following exceptions to the SKK Show regulations will apply at the European Dog Show and the Swedish Winner Show 2026:

Rule 25 – Puppy Class

This class will not be organised.

Rule 27 – Junior Competition Class

The best dog in the Junior Competition Class awarded Excellent and CK, and which has not already been awarded the Swedish Junior Champion title, will be awarded a Junior Certificate.

Rule 37 – Veteran Competition Class

The best dog in the Veteran Competition Class awarded Excellent and CK, and which has not already been awarded the Swedish Veteran Champion title, will be awarded a Veteran Certificate.

Rule 40 – Progeny Class

This class will not be organised.

Rule 41 – Breeders' Class

This class is open to a group of three to five dogs of the same breed or breed variety (size and/or coat type), all bearing the same kennel name or bred by the same person or group of persons.

Rule 42 – Final Competitions

- At the Swedish Winner Show, only Group Finals for Groups 1–10 and Best in Show will be organised.
- At the European Dog Show, Group Finals for Groups 1–10, Best Junior, Best Veteran, Best Breeders' Group, Best in Show, as well as special final competitions in Junior Handling, will be organised.

SKK Champion regulations

Exceptions to the regulations for the Swedish Show Champion (SE UCh)

Applicable at the European Dog Show and the Swedish Winner Show

- For breeds requiring a working qualification for the title SE UCh:
 - For foreign-owned dogs that obtain a show merit qualifying for SE UCh, a Working Class Certificate (WCC) will be accepted as the required working qualification, regardless of which working qualification is otherwise specified in the regulations for SE UCh.
 - In all other respects, the standard regulations for SE UCh as set out in the regulations for SE UCh will apply.

Swedish Junior Champion

Three junior certificates received by three different judges.

Swedish Veteran Champion

Three veteran certificates received by three different judges.
