

Seek funds for your research

For example, if you are a researcher or a veterinarian and you are conducting research on pets, you can apply for funds from the Agria and SKK Research Fund. You will find more information on how to go about it here.

Submit your application via the research fund's electronic application system. You can read about how to go about it under the heading "Instructions" in the menu on the left-hand side.

Two-step application

The application is carried out in two steps In step 1, applicants for research funding submit a brief outline that is assessed in terms of its relevance and potential. Applications for salary subsidies can be submitted. After a decision by the research committee, an invitation is sent to the applicants that progress to step 2. Applications must be written in Swedish or English.

Step 1-The application must contain a project description of a maximum of 3 pages (standard font and standard character size) containing:

- Purpose and objectives
- Background to the project
- Summary of materials and methods
- Any preliminary results
- Total funds sought, giving reasons
- Other persons participating in the project
- Literature list
- Previous or current funding for projects sought

Applications may be submitted for a maximum of SEK 1 million per year. The Fund does not grant funds for conference travel.

In step 2, invited applicants must submit a full application, containing:

- A more detailed description of the project consisting of a maximum of 5 pages in Swedish or English: the purpose, objectives and expected results of the project
- Description of theory, methods and implementation
- Ethical considerations
- Benefits of the project for the small animal sector
- A summary of previous research in the field and a description of how the project applied for is connected with research already carried out
- National and international cooperation
- Other participants and their function in the project
- Justification of the budget
- CV, including publication list
- Plan for scientific publication and dissemination of information
- A brief description of the project in Swedish or English for publication on the Fund's website

Who can apply?

Applicants should preferably be affiliated with universities, research institutions and other organisations such as animal hospitals. Funds cannot be provided for private individuals with no such connection. There must be an impartial financial unit that is able to manage the subsidies.

Important dates

Step 1 is open **1 - 30 April**.

Step 2 is open **1 - 30 September**.
